Ronald Green, founder of Ronald Everett Design, is from the Tsimshian community of Lax Kw'alaams in Northern British Columbia. Ron earned his BFA at the University of Victoria, graduating with distinction. And as an accomplished artist, Ron's work has been exhibited in Ontario and British Columbia; his traditional blanket work adorns the walls of locations at resorts and hotels in Canada, the United States and Europe.

In making the transition from artist to designer, Ron studied at the International Academy of Design in Toronto where he graduated at the head of his class with an award-winning collection of Native inspired designs. After graduating, Ron worked as a designer for a local clothing manufacturer and then developed his own brand and company under the name of Ronald Everett Design.

Today, Ron's clothing designs are sold around the world, from North America to Germany to the Philippines; he is a member of the Toronto Aboriginal Business Association (TABA), the Association for Native Development in the Performing and Visual Arts (ANDPVA), and works with community organization such as Miziwe Biik, a development and employment agency for the Native community.
