Raised to honour her traditional values and ancestry, Tammy started making traditional garments when she was just a young girl and today, her one-of-a-kind pieces are showcased in prestigious museums across North America including the Heard Museum, Eitel Jorge Museum, the Smithsonian Museum and the Masuntucket Pequot Museum.

Using the inspiration from Iroquoian art, themes and symbolism, Tammy combines high quality materials and fabrics to create wearable art; all merchandise is authentic to Native traditions and produced on Mohawk Territory by Tammy and her team of Mohawk women.
